### LOW LEVEL PARACHUTE (LLP MK1)

The Low Level Parachute LLP Mk1 allows fully equipped airborne troops to carry out massed tactical parachute assaults from jump heights as low as 76 m (250 feet). The parachute is in service with the Airborne and Special Forces of the UK and Sweden.
